Dear Madeline, Sylvan and Brian,

I hope you are all well. I'm writing to you as part of the Hollywood business and government community, to express our concern about the steep rise in crime in the area.

There have been multiple assault and robbery incidents recently right outside our store and its surroundings, and our customer traffic in the evenings has greatly suffered due to this. Our store manager Jose Aros (cc'd here) has contacted the BID's security multiple times and they've refused to attend to these incidents. If this will continue to be the case, I seriously question the need for them at all, or the need to pay a yearly merchant fee for their services.

Jose can follow up with you directly to give you more details. I'm also happy to meet to discuss concrete solutions to this problem.
