Thank you for the recent packet of information you sent. I have a few more requests which, if it's agreeable to you, perhaps we could handle on the same terms (although I am perfectly willing to reimburse you all for postage as well as copying if you wish). I would, however, prefer electronic copies of these if you have them, as discussed in section 6253.9 of the CA PRA.

These are:

1. A copy of the HPOA 2014-15 Strategic Work Plan that was approved at the Board's meeting of October 16, 2014.
2. A copy of the letter sent by HPOA to the state controller regarding delinquent parcels in the BID.

Finally, I have a more complex request, for which I am not able to identify specifically the documents involved. Probably, although not certainly, I will have to come over and look at a selection of documents in order to be able to find the information I'm looking for. I would like to see materials that explain the operating instructions, rules of engagement, goals, mission, etc. given by the HPOA to Andrews International Security. That is, what particularly the HPOA hires them to do and what instructions they have been given to do this. I understand that this information may not be contained in a single document and that it may take time to assemble the materials. Please let me know.
