- > It is important to note that we will be meeting at the Hollywood
- > Athletic Club (6525 Sunset Blvd.), instead of AMPAS on Tuesday
- > (11/11) at 4 p.m. This is due to a request from a member of the
- > public that is challenging our use of buildings that have a security
- > check-in.

- > As you all know, we are subject to the Brown Act (i.e. Open Meetings
- > Law) and the Public Records Act, and do our best to conform to the
- > policies therewith, however we are exploring whether the security
- > check-in is in fact obstructing any access to our meetings. Under

> the Brown Act, a member of the public is not required to identify  
> themselves or sign in at a meeting. What is not clear is whether that  
> meeting can be held in a location that has a security check-in (e.g.,  
> City Hall, which requires security check in to attend the city council  
> meeting). With an abundance of caution we are going to meet at an  
> unrestricted location this month until we are advised by counsel on  
> how to proceed. Just wanted you all to be aware.
